



【活動主題】2026 第十四屆綠衣使節美國南加州參訪（7 月 6 日）

【活動地點】洛杉磯市政廳

【活動報導】

七月六日上午，使節們前往洛杉磯市中心參觀，並由當地校友學姊帶領進行城市探索，依序參訪了洛杉磯聖母大教堂、華特·迪士尼音樂廳以及天使鐵路，儘管這只是洛杉磯市中心的一小部分，卻足以讓使節們感受到這座城市深厚的歷史底蘊與多元文化風貌，也對洛杉磯的城市發展、建築特色及人文景觀有了更深入的認識。

隨後，綠衣使節團前往洛杉磯市政廳參訪，藉此加深對民主政治運作的瞭解以及拓展國際視野。洛杉磯市政廳位於洛杉磯市的市中心，興建於 1928 年，為洛杉磯的行政中心。在市政廳導覽人員的帶領與詳細解說下，使節們依序參觀了觀景台和 Tom Bradley Hall。Tom Bradley Hall 的命名是為了紀念 Tom Bradley，他是洛杉磯市史上首位非裔美國人市長，象徵美國種族平權的進步。透過近距離的觀察，使節們得以了解市政運作的實際情形，更對美國地方自治與民主政治的運作有了更深入的認知。

此次參訪行程，我們有幸與國際關係處處長 Taylor Redick 會面。處長首先誠摯地歡迎我們的到來，並提到洛杉磯市與臺北市為姊妹市，期待日後能夠有更多交流，維繫姊妹市的美好情誼。在提問環節，使節們也踴躍地發問，向處長請教有關政治實務的問題，處長也都一一詳細答覆，氣氛十分愉悅，使節們都從中得到很大的啟發。在參訪的尾聲，使節們致贈了鳳梨酥、小綠娃、錦旗與感謝狀，並於處長合影，為此次參訪畫下一個完美的句點。

此次參訪洛杉磯市中心，使節們除了更加了解市政廳的運作，也對於洛杉磯這個城市有了更深的認識，更體會到這座國際大都會如何在歷史文化、藝術建築與現代發展之間取得平衡。

On the morning of July 6th, the ambassadors visited the Los Angeles City Hall, aiming to gain a deeper insight into the workings of democratic politics and to broaden their international horizon.

The Los Angeles City Hall was built in 1928, located in downtown Los Angeles City, and serves as the city's administrative center. With the city hall docents' leading and their detailed explanations, the ambassadors toured the observation deck and Tom Bradley Hall in sequence. The hall was named after the first African-American mayor, Tom Bradley, to represent a significant milestone in America's racial equality. Through the closing observation, the ambassadors were able to understand the practical operations of municipal governance, gaining a more profound comprehension of the operation of American local autonomy and democratic politics.

During this visit, we had the distinct honor to meet with Taylor Redick, the Director of International Relations. The Director first welcomed us sincerely and noted that Los Angeles and Taipei are sister cities, hoping for further exchanges in the future to maintain the bond between the two sister cities. During the Q&A session, the ambassadors enthusiastically asked questions about practical politics. The atmosphere was warm and engaging, and the ambassadors drew great inspiration from the exchange. At the end of the visit, the student ambassadors presented the gifts to the Director, including a doll wearing the uniform, a box of pineapple cake, a flag, and a certificate. The ambassadors also took a group photo with the Director, bringing the visit to a successful conclusion.

Through the visit to the Los Angeles City Hall, the ambassadors not only gained a better understanding of democratic operations but also developed a deeper connection with the city of Los Angeles, truly realizing the complexity and diversity of municipal governance.
